



Criteria for team selection for 2011 FEI World Dressage Challenge

The following criteria will be used to govern the creation of the 2011 FEI World Dressage team:

- Results from any dressage competition (including the dressage section of Combined Training/Eventing competitions) judged by international, foreign judges starting January 2010 will be eligible for consideration. This information will be used by the TTEA management committee to create a short list of eligible team members. This will be worth 50% of the consideration.
- The trials in January 2011 will be worth 50% of the consideration. At this event all eligible team members must compete in the test they will be riding in FEI as their first test on the horse they will be competing on.
- Based on these two pieces of information the TTEA management committee will create a team.
- Eligible riders must have competed in their test on their horse as their first test in at least one other show plus ride that test on that horse as their first test at the January 2011 trials to be considered.
- Please note with horses that are shared or compete in multiple tests only the results from the horse's first test (i.e. the first time the horse is in the ring) will count. Riders that share a horse that would both like to be considered must ensure they have at least one first entry in 2010. In the January 2011 trials only the first rider's test will be considered in this case.
